

Threat Update Service* Advisory

March 8, 2013

Purpose: The Corero Security Active Response Team informs customers that existing IPS 5500 security features provide proactive protection against known attacks targeting the FreeBSD 9.1 ftpd Remote Denial of Service.

Issue: The glob implementation in FreeBSD 9.1 does not properly evaluate expressions thereby allowing a remote attacker to cause a denial of service via a crafted FTP STAT command.

Recommended Action: Enable the specified rule and ensure that the rule is used to inspect traffic to the affected product infrastructure.
